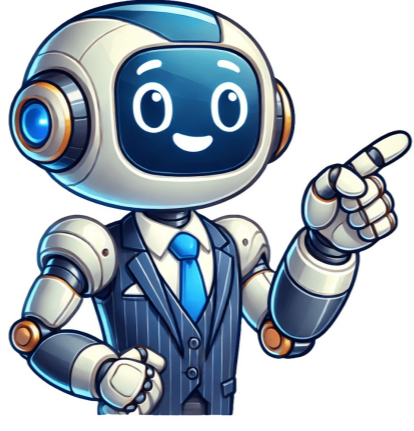

King's Theatre Glasgow: A Century of EntertainmentKings Theatre in Glasgow has been a prominent venue for over a century, hosting various events such as pantomime performances and musicals. The theatre was designed by Frank Matcham with Art Nouveau influences and opened its doors in 1904.The King's Theatre has hosted many notable performers over the years, including Dolly Parton and The Jackson Five at the Royal Variety Performance in 1977. In 1990, Glasgow became European City of Culture, and the theatre played a significant role in this celebration.One of the theatres most popular events is its annual pantomime, which has featured Scottish greats such as Stanley Baxter, Jimmy Logan, and Jack Milroy. The theatre was designed by renowned architect Frank Matcham and constructed by T.N. Kingerlee & Sons.##ARTICLEThe Ilford Empire, built in 1913, was the first purpose-built cinema run by Alexander Bernstein and later became known as The Empire Cinema. Unfortunately, the theatre suffered a devastating loss during World War II when it was hit by a bomb on September 17, 1940. Despite its tragic fate, Percy G. Court's account of his time working at the Empire provides insight into the theatre's life during wartime.The Theatre featured a unique proscenium-arched stage and had limited amenities, including just two dressing rooms. Improvements were made in 1922, but the theatre was later acquired by the Ben Jay circuit and renamed The Empire Cinema. Sadly, this marked the beginning of the end for the Ilford Empire.In an interesting parallel, another historic theatre in the area, The Hippodrome, also met a similar fate during World War II. A bomb destroyed the structure, leaving it uninhabitable. The nearby King's Theatre, however, has survived and is now one of Scotland's most iconic venues.Kings Theatre Glasgow, Scotland's most historic theatre, first opened its doors in 1904 as a sister theatre for Theatre Royal for Howard Wyndham Ltd. It serves mainly as a reception venue for touring dance, musicals, comedy and acrobatic shows. Owned by the Glasgow City Council, it is operated by Ambassador Theatre Group. Designed by Frank Matcham, the building features two facades with Art Nouveau and Baroque influences. The theatre has undergone renovations since World War II, including the extension of its Bath Street elevation in 1986. In 2008, the interior was refurbished to restore its former glory.The King's Theatre Glasgow offers various amenities such as bars, the Ambassador Experience package, and The Picture Lounge cocktail bar. Facilities include workshops for all ages and backstage tours. The theatre features three transfer seats and five wheelchair spaces, with an infrared audio system for patrons with hearing disabilities. Over the years, it has hosted famous shows, including Half-Past Eight variety shows, pantos like A Wish for Jamie, and performances by well-known actors.
