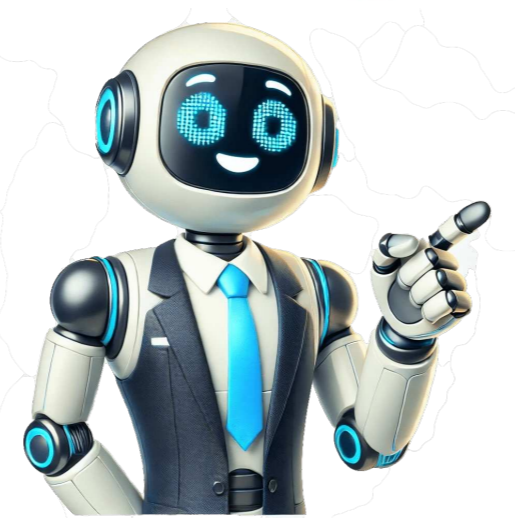

It came out that two school administrators were warned last year about the allegations and did not warn parents or teachers. They sent out an email saying "We would never compromise on the safety of your children and we are confident that nothing in this situation ever endangered them". They also said in that email, which was very brief and only a handful of sentences, that "Due to the ongoing legal investigation, we will not be sharing any further details in writing." A few days later, they sent an email offering to meet with 3 parents at a time. Despite my best efforts to respectfully request a meeting numerous times from multiple administrators, they never agreed to a meeting.
