The show has a total of 130 episodes divided into 7 seasons and was revived by Netflix in 2021. The series revolves around Johnny Test, an 11-year-old boy who lives with his super-genius twin sisters, Susan and Mary. With the help of his dog Duke, Johnny occasionally saves the world with his sisters' inventions. The series features a variety of characters, including Hugh Test, Lila Test, Gil Nexdor, Mr. Black, and Mr. White. Deep Sea Johnny: Johnny invents a device that lets him breathe underwater, but when he reverses the process, a shark, squid, and electric eels start walking on land and wreak havoc on the beach. Johnny & the Amazing Turbo Action Backpack: Johnny gets an incredible backpack that can do everything his Baby Barf Backpack can't. However, Bling-Bling Boy steals it, and Johnny must retrieve it so Susan and Mary can show it off at the school science fair. Johnny and the Ice Pigs: Johnny travels back in time to ask Thomas Edison for a hockey invention and then gathers ruthless "legends" to form a team that will help the Ice Pigs win a game. Johnny's House of Horrors: Johnny fills his house with Hugh's favorite things, but accidentally uses his nightmare journal instead. To make matters worse, Lila's boss is coming over for dinner that night. Johnny's Super Smarty Pants: Johnny wears super smarty pants to impress a genius girl named Janet Nelson Jr. However, the pants soon develop a mind of their own. Take Your Johnny to Work Day: Johnny sneaks into Lila's car with Susan and Mary on Take Your Daughter to Work Day, thinking it's unfair that girls don't have to go to school on this day. They accidentally release a missile in a lab at Lila's workplace. Johnny and the Mega Roboticles: Johnny brings his toy Nasteria to life, which decides to destroy Porkbelly. He must stop the evil action figure with a toy force led by Nasteria's arch-nemesis, Mega Roboticle. Johnny Gets Mooned: Johnny steals a rocket his sisters made to travel to the moon and write his report. Instead, he battles moon monsters and rescues Canadian astronauts. Johnny Hollywood: When Dad won't let him watch it, Johnny uses a gadget to enter The Quickest and the Monkiest movie, but gets stuck when the power goes out. He must escape with Dukey before the movie ends badly. Johnny's Turbo Time Rewinder: Johnny's sisters invent a time rewinder that can go back up to 5 minutes, which they use to get him in trouble by breaking Hugh's favorite bowling ball. However, the episode was unsuccessful; eventually, Bling-Bling Boy provides Johnny with a similar device. The "Time Rewinder" gadget that Bling-Bling Boy gave to Johnny helps him retrieve his skateboard and bicycle by finding one of Hugh's shoes. The episodes in this season include: "The Return of Johnny X," where Johnny becomes Johnny X again to stop Bling-Bling's new evil invention, Repto-Slicer; "Sonic Johnny," where Johnny and Dukey travel into the future after trying Susan and Mary's ultimate scooter and find they are wanted by the police. The second season also features "The Dog Days of Johnny," where Susan and Mary put a device on Dukey that makes him obey their commands, and "Johnny's Pink Plague," where Johnny uses a gadget to cure everyone's acne but discovers the device is unstable. Other episodes in this season include: "Johnny's Extreme Game Controller," where Johnny controls people with a Mega Action Game Controller, but Hugh gets his hands on it; and "Lil' Johnny," where Johnny accidentally shrinks himself and Dukey into a sub-atomic universe while shrinking his toys, leading to unexpected chaos. The third season consists of episodes such as "Johnny vs. Brain Freezer," where Johnny must stop the villain Brain Freezer and unfreeze everyone he has frozen; and "Johnny's Big Snow Job," where Johnny uses a device in Susan and Mary's lab to make it snow outside, but the whole city becomes snowed over instead. Additionally, this season includes "Johnny Dodgeball," where Johnny uses a bionic arm to beat Sissy at dodgeball, but it breaks after being exposed to cereal; and "Johnny & the Attack of the Monster Truck," where Eugene brings a living monster truck to the Test house that starts destroying its own kind, prompting Johnny to find a solution. All episodes in this season were directed by Joseph Sherman. Toy Force: Wacko, an evil toymaker, gives out robots that imprison the children of Porkbelly. The gang seeks aid from the Turbo Toy Force. JTV: Johnny starts his own channel over the EBC, broadcasting emergencies and tests. Later, the army needs the channel for a runaway plane. Johnny vs. Bling Bling 2: Eugene creates a device that reverses himself, Johnny, and Dukey back into young children, disrupting Johnny's video game showdown with Sissy. Johnnyland: Johnny builds a theme park called Johnnyland in his backyard, but Hugh demands it be torn down, only to stumble upon an unstable ride with Lila. Johnny's Got a Brand New Dad: Hugh's constant "no" sayings infuriate Johnny, so they create a new one. However, the new dad gets exposed to plutonium, causing things to take a turn. Saturday Night's Alright for Johnny: Johnny tries to have the perfect Saturday, but Sissy ruins it by practicing William Tell archery on him. Johnny uses Susan and Mary's Saturday Repeater machine to try again. Johnny Mint Chip: Johnny, Dukey, and the sisters visit an ice cream factory to get the recipe for mint chip ice cream. Johnny's Pet Day: Dukey gets jealous when Johnny takes Repto-Slicer to school for Pet Day and not him. This lands him in danger of becoming a TV star. Phat Johnny: An accident in Eugene's lab leaves Johnny overweight like him, prompting him to become a rapper and get a video game he wants. The Revenge of Johnny X: Bling-Bling Boy's Alien pod captures Susan, forcing Johnny and Dukey to defeat him and save her. The Enchanted Land of Johnnia: Johnny and Dukey catch rainy day boredom and use one of the sisters' devices, thinking it's an inter-dimnsoinal travel machine, and enter a land known as Johnnia. 101 Johnnies: Johnny accidentally creates 100 robot clones of himself to do his chores, but they become defective soon after. Johnny Zombie Tea Party: Johnny brings Porkbelly's founders back to life to help with his report. FellowMark FellowsJeff Barker/Dan NosellaFebruary 24, 2007 This episode, "Johnny Test in Black & White", involves Black & White spying on Susan and Mary. This leads to Johnny and Dukey shrinking themselves and ending up in Mr. Black's brain. They cause him to forget that he was supposed to spy on Susan and Mary. Later, "Johnny the Kid" takes place at a dude ranch where Johnny's family goes to relax. However, they are invaded by an outlaw motorcycle club. With the help of Bling-Bling Boy and Gil, Johnny and his friends stop the bikers from ruining their vacation. "Down Hill Johnny" sees Johnny visiting the Behemoth ski resort. He has to find a way to go downhill despite being underage. In "Johnny Meets the Pork-Ness Monster", Johnny's family searches for a place to cool off on a hot day. They visit Lake Pork-Ness, which is said to have a monster living in it. However, they soon discover that the monster is actually a robot. "The Good, the Bad & the Johnny" involves the girls splitting Johnny's bad genes into two separate ones, making him 100% good. However, one of these genes gets out and creates an evil version of Johnny. In "Rock-A-Bye Johnny", Dukey keeps Johnny up all night, causing his parents to go sleepwalking. "00-Johnny" involves Tim Burnout stealing blueprints from the girls' plan for alternating Dukey and using them on his cat. However, he becomes evil and it's up to Johnny and Dukey to stop him. "Johnny of the Jungle" sees Johnny and Dukey helping animals get to their homeland in Africa while on a class trip to the safari park. "Johnny vs. Smash Badger 3" involves Johnny accidentally bringing Smash Badger to life through his video game cheat codes. In "Johnny Bee Good", The Bee Keeper steals all the candy in Porkbelly, and it's up to Johnny, Dukey, and the girls to stop him. Johnny Applause Inspired to be a hero after learning about American heroes, Johnny becomes a vigilante but lands in trouble. Johnny'mon Johnny Dukey Susan and Mary are transported into Tiny'Mon. They must defeat Blast Ketchup and Kadoomerang using Cuddlebuns for protection. Bathtime for Johnny Johnny refuses to bathe because he wanted to get his brother Dukey the best present ever. Johnny Test: Monster Starter Mr Black and Mr White ask Susan and Mary to design a helmet that can control things with the mind. But its stuck on Johnny's head when it gets misused. "Johnny Holiday" Series: A Boy's Wild Adventures The video game has an unexpected side effect on Johnny. He starts transforming any inanimate object he sees into a monster. Johnny creates "Kids Get Free Candy Day" to spread happiness and gets support from the Beekeeper, despite adult protests. Meanwhile, a new movie adaptation of Johnny is released, but it's terrible. To stop him, Johnny, Dukey, Susan, and Mary must win another battle with Blast. Meanwhile, a condemned hotel gets haunted by ghosts, prompting Johnny, Dukey, and friends to investigate and prove the existence of the ghosts. In the "Johnny X" series, Johnny obtains mutant powers like Johnny X and Super Dukey, but faces off against Dark Vegan who returns to conquer Earth. In the "Porta-Johnny" episode, Johnny uses cunning to obtain teleporting powers from his sisters by threatening to mix some weird concoction with green food coloring from the unstable cabinet. However, Susan and Mary retaliate by messing with the powers. The twins later accidentally get caught up in an art robbery scenario. Later on, "Join the Johnny Scouts" features Johnny becoming a Lady Bird Scout after crashing his bike into a garbage truck. He tries to sell cookies to afford a new one, but Sissy also wants the bike for reasons of her own. In another episode, "Johnny B.C.", Johnny travels back in time to get a sloth bone for the twins, but upon returning, he becomes a caveman and skips his grounding for selling Hugh's belongings. "Runaway Johnny" sees Johnny and Dukey fleeing when their parents say they're too old for chores but not mature enough to watch PG-13 movies. In "Johnny on the Spot," Johnny steals a portable black hole that ultimately brings about an early apocalypse. "Dark Johnny" has Johnny teaming up with Dark Vegan to get him back home, while in "No Homework for Johnny", Susan and Mary build a robot to help Johnny with his homework, but it ends up stealing things for him instead. "Papa Johnny" features Johnny getting tired of being bossed around by Hugh, so the twins switch their brains after making a bet involving each other's lives. In "The Johnnyminstor Dog Show," Johnny and Dukey try to get into a dog show that only allows purebred dogs. The series revolves around the adventures of Johnny Test, a young boy with superpowers, and his twin sisters Susan and Mary. In "Who's Johnny?," Johnny's mail-order foam monster comes to life after the twins swap the water in his glass with their own drink. In "Princess Johnny", Johnny poses as a princess to prevent war, while Susan and Mary decide they want to act like normal girls. Meanwhile, the Tests go on vacation and sneak Dukey into the hotel. In the animated series Johnny Test, several episodes aired between September and December 2010. The episode "King Johnny" features Johnny becoming obsessed with domination after his sisters bring his chess pieces to life. Another episode, "Johnny Re-Animated," involves Johnny using an invention to bring cartoon characters Dawg & Bone into the real world to scare his sister Sissy. However, the characters mistake Porkbelly for a zombie world and attempt to destroy it. The family also celebrates Lila's birthday in "Johnny Cakes," where Johnny struggles to make her breakfast, while Hugh tries to find an inexpensive yet suitable gift. In "Johnny Tube," Johnny attempts to become an internet sensation by recording a successful video. Other episodes include "Sleepover at Johnny's," where Johnny is dragged into his sisters' plan to get Gil to attend a sleepover, and "Johnny's Got a... Wart!," where Johnny gets a wart that his sisters try to remove, but it unexpectedly gains intelligence. This is the last episode with Louis Chiriló as Dukey, like season 3, where all episodes are directed by Larry Jacobs. Johnny's show is in danger of being shut down by his owner. To save it, Johnny and Dukey help Mr. Black and Mr. White catch a runaway robot dog that could explode at any moment. In another episode, Johnny competes with his friends and enemies in a lawn mower race. He also tries to impress Sissy by building the ultimate treehouse using worker drones. Johnny accidentally turns his sisters into vampiresess while trying to become bigger and stronger. He must save Gil from getting bitten by his lovestruck vampirress sisters and cure them. In another episode, Johnny eats peach yogurt containing growth serum, which makes him lose his mind and turn into a Hulk-like monster causing destruction. Johnny's show is in danger once more when people try to steal the key that can open any lock in Porkbelly. His mother also forces him to wear a big winter coat at school, but he uses it as a weapon to defend against aliens. In another episode, Johnny and his friends go camping together, but things take an unexpected turn when Bigfoot falls in love with monster Dukey. "Johnny's Adventures" The main character, Johnny, is often depicted as a mischievous boy who frequently lies. In one episode, Johnny and his friends race super awesome video game go-carts to see who wins. Johnny also swipes the girls' voice-replicating invention and turns them against each other.
