As of December 2015, the bank had assets exceeding US\$12.2 billion (NGN:2.412 trillion) and shareholders' equity of approximately US\$1.86 billion (NGN:367.8 billion). With subsidiaries in eight Sub-Saharan African countries and the United Kingdom, Access Bank's headquarters are located in Lagos, Nigeria. Access Bank has a rich history dating back to 1989 when it received its license from the Central Bank of Nigeria. The bank was listed on the Nigerian Stock Exchange in 1996. In 2002, new management led by Aigboje Aig-imokhuede and Herbert Wigwe took over, followed by acquisitions of Marina Bank and Capital Bank in 2005.
